THE LADDER OF MANHOOD

Jeff Perera is a Community Engagement Manager for the White Ribbon Campaign (whiteribbon.ca), the world's largest effort to engage men and boys in re-imaging masculinity and helping end gender-based violence and violence against women. In 2010, Jeff delivered the TEDx talk 'Words Speak Louder Than Actions' discussing gender roles, the impact we all make and the impact words have on our everyday lives. He is the founder and director of the annual 'What Makes a Man' White Ribbon Conference. Born in Canada and of Sri Lankan decent, Jeff's awareness-raising initiatives to create inclusive spaces for people of all walks of life have earned him numerous human rights and equity awards.
